

**ORDINANCE NO. 1125**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE SPEEDWAY MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPEEDWAY INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, IC § 36-1-3-2 (the “Act”) confers upon the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”), all the powers needed for the effective operation of government; and

WHEREAS, in order to pursue the public purposes of the Act, the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) now desires to amend Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code for the establishment of the “Speedway Infrastructure Advisory Council” .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to IC § 36-1-3-2, the Speedway Infrastructure Advisory Council, is hereby created for the purposes as provided in Section 2 below.

Section 2. Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code is hereby amended to include Chapter 2.53 and read as follows:

“Chapter 2.53 Speedway Infrastructure Advisory Council

Functions: The Speedway Infrastructure Advisory Council (the “Council”) is an advisory council that works cooperatives with and reports to the Town Council and the Town Manager of the Town of Speedway, Indiana and is responsible for but not limited to the following:

- (1) The review of infrastructure in the Town and specifically in areas not included in the redevelopment areas of the Town; and
- (2) The preparation of recommendations for future improvements and upgrades for the Town’s infrastructure, and
- (3) The review of options for amenities, improvements and signage in the Town of Speedway.

Members: There will be eight (8) members of the Council selected as follows:

- (1) One (1) member appointed by **each** of the members of the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) who resides in the respective Council member’s district for a term concurrent with the life of the Council;

- (2) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council who is employed by an engineering or architectural firm, has been educated similarly, and/or has worked 5+ years as an engineer, designer, architect or related role within the past 25 years of their career for a term concurrent with the life of the Council;
- (3) The Town Manager for a term concurrent with the life of the Council; and
- (4) The Street Commissioner of the Town for a term concurrent with the life of the Council.

All members of the Council, except the Town Manager, must be residents of the Town for at least one (1) year prior to his/her appointment. The Town Manager and Street Commissioner shall facilitate and guide the process and coordinate the activities of the Council. The group shall select a Secretary at its first meeting. After a period of 18 months, a decision shall be made to make permanent the Infrastructure Advisory Council.

Meetings: The Council will meet on an as-needed basis. The Council is subject to the laws, rules and regulations of the Town and the State of Indiana.”

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its having been passed by the Town Council and signed by the Town Council.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1126**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE SPEEDWAY MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPEEDWAY HOUSING ADVISORY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, IC § 36-1-3-2 (the “Act”) confers upon the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”), all the powers needed for the effective operation of government; and

WHEREAS, in order to pursue the public purposes of the Act, the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) now desires to amend Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code for the establishment of the “Speedway Housing Advisory Council” .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to IC § 36-1-3-2, the Speedway Housing Advisory Council, is hereby created for the purposes as provided in Section 2 below.

Section 2. Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code is hereby amended to include Chapter 2.52 and read as follows:

“Chapter 2.52 Speedway Housing Advisory Council.

Functions: The Speedway Housing Advisory Council (the “Council”) is an advisory council that works cooperatively with and reports to the Town Council and the Town Manager of the Town of Speedway, Indiana and is responsible for but not limited to the following:

- (1) The review of housing and related real estate issues facing the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”) in order to advance, enhance and promote the availability of diverse and quality housing in the Town;
- (2) Applications for grant money on behalf of the Town to assist in the development of housing initiatives and programs in the Town;
- (3) The development of an inventory and action plan for homes located in the Town that are abandoned or in foreclosure;
- (4) The implementation of options for potential housing developments to serve specific demographic groups; and

- (5) The review of housing options and development in the redevelopment areas located in the Town.

Members: There will be five (5) members of the Council selected as follows:

- (1) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council of the Town (the "Town Council") for a term of 3 years;
- (2) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council based on the recommendation of the Speedway Redevelopment Commission for a term of 2 years;
- (3) One (1) member shall be a licensed realtor in good standing in the State of Indiana, appointed by the Town Council for a term of 3 years ;
- (4) One (1) at-large member appointed by the Town Council with relevant development, real estate or construction experience for a term of 1 year; and
- (5) One (1) member appointed by the Town Council based upon the recommendation of the Building Commissioner of the Town of Speedway.

All members of the Council must be residents of the Town for at least one (1) year prior to his/her appointment and no more than four (4) members of the Council may be of the same political party. The Town Manager will serve as a non-voting adhoc member of the Council. Initially, the Town Council member or their designee will serve as the President, and following the first year, the members of the Council will elect a President and a Vice-President.

Meetings: The Council will meet at least once per month. The Council is subject to the laws, rules and regulations of the Town and the State of Indiana."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its having been passed by the Town Council and signed by the Town Council.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1127**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE SPEEDWAY MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPEEDWAY ARTS ADVISORY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, IC § 36-1-3-2 (the “Act”) confers upon the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”), all the powers needed for the effective operation of government; and

WHEREAS, in order to pursue the public purposes of the Act, the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) now desires to amend Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code for the establishment of the “Speedway Arts Advisory Council” .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to IC § 36-1-3-2, the Speedway Arts Advisory Council, is hereby created for the purposes as provided in Section 2 below.

Section 2. Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code is hereby amended to include Chapter 2.51 and read as follows:

“Chapter 2.51 Speedway Arts Advisory Council.

Functions: The Speedway Arts Advisory Council (the “Council”) is an advisory council that works cooperatives with and reports to the Town Council and the Town Manager of the Town of Speedway, Indiana and is responsible for the following:

- (1) The creation and implementation of public arts initiatives, programs and policies for the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”). This includes, but is not limited to, the creation of a public art master plan, the integration of public art into capital programs and projects, where appropriate, and working cooperatively with the Town of Speedway Redevelopment Council on placement, selection and development of grant programs to assist arts programs in the Town;
- (2) The development of arts programs through the Parks Department of the Town, and development of art in the park initiatives;
- (3) Make applications for grant money on behalf of the Town; and

- (4) The enhancement and promotion all types of arts within the Town.

Members: There will be five (5) members of the Council selected as follows:

- (1) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) for a term of 2 years;
- (2) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council upon the recommendation of the Speedway Redevelopment Commission for a term of 2 years;
- (3) Two (2) members appointed by the Town Council each for a term of 1 year, one of whom must have direct relevant experience with the arts, either through teaching at an accredited school, college or university, a business ownership or college degree. The two members cannot be of the same political party; and
- (4) One (1) representative appointed by the Town Council for a term of one year from the civic or not-for-profit community of the Town of Speedway.

At least four (4) of the members of the Council must be residents of the Town for at least one (1) year prior to his/her appointment. Initially, the Town Council member or their designee will serve as the President, and following the first year, the members of the Council will elect a President and a Vice-President.

Meetings: The Council will meet at least once per month. The Council is subject to the laws, rules and regulations of the Town and the State of Indiana.”

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its having been passed by the Town Council and signed by the Town Council.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1128**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE SPEEDWAY MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SPEEDWAY CIVIC EVENT ADVISORY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, IC § 36-1-3-2 (the “Act”) confers upon the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”), all the powers needed for the effective operation of government; and

WHEREAS, in order to pursue the public purposes of the Act, the Town Council of the Town (the “Town Council”) now desires to amend Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code for the establishment of the “Speedway Civic Event Advisory Council” .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to IC § 36-1-3-2, the Speedway Civic Event Advisory Council, is hereby created for the purposes as provided in Section 2 below.

Section 2. Title 2 of the Speedway Municipal Code is hereby amended to include Chapter 2.54 and read as follows:

“Chapter 2.54 Speedway Civic Event Advisory Council.

Functions: The Speedway Civic Event Advisory Council (the “Council”) is an advisory council that works cooperatively with and reports to the Town Manager of the Town of Speedway, Indiana and is responsible for the following:

- (1) The creation of the framework for the consideration and approval of non-race special events or special events held in conjunction with the race that require support or resources of the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”);
- (2) The development of permitting and community standards for such events; and
- (3) The creation of fee waiver provisions for events and an application system by which events are received, supported and recommended to the Town Council for final approval.

Members: There will be seven (7) members of the Council selected as follows:

- (1) One (1) member or a designee appointed at large by the Town Council for a term of three (3) years;
- (2) One (1) member or a designee appointed by the Town Council engaged in the motor sports industry for a term of two (2) years;
- (3) One member or a designee appointed by the Town Council upon the recommendation of the Speedway Parks and Recreation Board for a term of three (3) years;

The remaining four (4) seats shall be appointed by the Town Council from among the following groups and shall be made for terms of one year each on a rotating basis as terms expire at the discretion of the Town Council. Only one person per group may be appointed at any one time:

- (4) One member or a designee of the Speedway Lions Club;
- (5) One member who owns and operates a business on Main Street in Speedway;
- (6) One member or a designee of the Speedway Chamber of Commerce;
- (7) One member or a designee of the American Legion Post 500 in Speedway;
- (8) One member or a designee of the Speedway School Board;
- (9) One member or a designee of the Speedway Library Board.

The Town Manager and Town Clerk-Treasurer will each serve as non-voting ad hoc members of the Council. Initially, the Town Council member or their designee will serve as the President, and following the first year, the members of the Council will elect a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary.

Meetings: The Council will meet monthly or on an as-needed basis. The Council is subject to the laws, rules and regulations of the Town and the State of Indiana.”

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its having been passed by the Town Council and signed by the Town Council.
